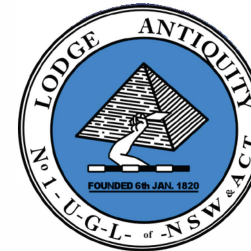

### MY WISH

I shall pass through this chair but once. If therefore there be any kindness I can show, or any good I can do, let me do it now, let me not defer it, or neglect it, for I shall not pass this way again.

## LODGE ANTIQUITY No.1

Freemasonry was first practiced in Australia on a regular basis by Lodges No. 227 and 218 Irish Constitution attached respectively to the 46<sup>th</sup> and 48<sup>th</sup> Regiments. The 46<sup>th</sup> left Sydney in August 1817 and were replaced by the 48<sup>th</sup>, which remained here for a few years after that date. Although the Grand Lodge of England had promulgated an edict in 1815 that Military Lodges under their jurisdiction could no longer initiate civilians, those under the Irish Constitution continued to do so. In that way several Sydney townspeople were admitted into Freemasonry. These Brethren naturally desired a lodge of their own and to that end in 1816 sent a petition to the Grand Lodge of Ireland supported by Lodge 227. There was no reply until well after the arrival of Lodge 218. On the 6<sup>th</sup> January 1820 the petition was granted and on the 12<sup>th</sup> August 1820 Lodge 218 conducted the ceremony of constituting the new Lodge Australian Social No. 260 I.C. The meeting was held in a tavern on the Kings Wharf, said to have been what is now Fleet Park. Matthew Bacon has the distinction of being the first Australian Worshipful Master and in that little lodge of twelve members Freemasonry had its origins in this country. First two initiates were Bros. James Campbell and Henry Lewis, each was Chief Officer of Calcutta Brigs then lying in Sydney cove, and who were on the 30<sup>th</sup> August initiated and passed in the presence of twelve Brethren, and just a week later raised to the Third Degree.

The original warrant dated 6<sup>th</sup> January 1820 was signed by His Grace Augustus Frederick the Duke of Leinster, Grand Master of The Grand Lodge of Ireland, and was brought out by Surgeon Price of the Royal Navy. No. 260 continued under its original name until the formation of The Grand Lodge of NSW when it took the name of Australian Social Mother No.0. On the formation of the U.G.L. in 1888 the name changed to Australian Social Mother Lodge No. 1 To mark the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the lodge in 1920 the name was again changed by motion of Bro. Henley to Antiquity No.1

On the 5<sup>th</sup> September 1988 Lodge Antiquity No. 1 consolidated with Lodge Celestial No. 512
